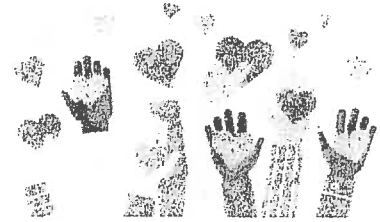

Business Description

Many Haitian refugees who have recently lost their status and right to work have come together as a community to volunteer themselves to neighbors, especially the elderly, who need help to maintain an independent lifestyle. This volunteer service may be in housekeeping, lawn maintenance, minor household repairs and any other service that enables people to maintain themselves in their homes. Monetary donations for work done will be used to support this volunteer community with food, housing and other necessities as their members need.
