One way to demonstrate your ongoing commitment to the health and safety of the community and to let people know you are taking all the recommended steps to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 is by taking the SEACOAST SAFE Pledge- an initiative of the Seacoast Chamber Alliance. By signing the Pledge you voluntarily agree that you are:

- Following current State of NH COVID-19 Reopening Guidelines.
- Requiring employees and customers to wear face coverings indoors and in public settings where social distancing measures are difficult to maintain. (Some Seacoast communities have mask ordinances- please check with the town for specific requirements for masks and face coverings.)
- Arranging public spaces for social distancing consistent with CDC guidelines.
- Having an alcohol-based hand sanitizer in high-traffic locations for employees and customers.
- Implementing workplace cleaning and disinfection practices that follow CDC guidelines including regular sanitation of high-touch surfaces.
- Not allowing employees with COVID-19 symptoms to work on-site.

When you voluntarily take the pledge, you will receive a window cling (pictured here) and you will have access to an online toolkit with downloadable graphics designed to help build awareness of the measures you are taking to keep the Seacoast safe, healthy and open. You will also be listed on the SEACOAST SAFE website that will be launched in the next few weeks- and as a member of one of the Chambers in the Seacoast Chamber Alliance, your listing will be linked back to your website.
