Our goal is to ensure that children experiencing the trauma of homelessness have the opportunity to celebrate their birthday joyfully, surrounded by family, friends and others who care.

Our Program

Our birthday parties have the power to make children feel both special and like a "regular kid". We provide much more than just cake, presents and goody bags. Birthday Wishes parties bring joy, hope and positive lasting memories.



Every month we deliver a Birthday-in-a-Box to children throughout New England, Long Island & New York City. Each brightly wrapped box is filled with party supplies, decorations, cake mix, frosting, goody bags, birthday gifts and of course candles for the all-important birthday wish. Our older teens receive a Teen-Birthday-in-a-Box with smaller gifts, a custom cookie and a gift card.
