Judy Mason's artist statement: "Man was meant to create and make a better world. The beauty of nature and all the abstract shapes that make up many objects here on earth, stimulates our creativity. I enjoy finding those abstractions and applying them in my artwork. It gives movement and interest to a surface. It brings entertainment and fulfillment in discovery. It depletes dullness from our existence."

Bio- Judy Mason was raised in Abilene, Texas, where sports and riding bikes were practiced for enjoyment. Exposure to the arts was minimal. After marriage and children, Mason began painting in a very traditional manner as it was the only thing she knew; she struggled for years to find pleasure in realistic painting. In 1986, Mason took a two week workshop with Louisiana instructor, M. Douglas Walton which broadened her views on painting. Mason's frustration eased, she found watercolors enjoyable, and she continued studying with Walton for 16 years.

In addition to her work, she also teaches art to both children and adults. Judy has exhibited work at numerous local, regional and international venues. She is a member of several local art venues, and is represented by the Center for Contemporary Art in Abilene and the Firehouse Art Gallery in Weatherford.








Charles Arnold receives his Artist of the Year award from past president, Jo Williams and current president, Mindy Faubion.
