Good Evening North Hills School Family,

I trust that you have received and read the email from the North Hills Leadership Team sent this evening regarding North Hills' response to Coronavirus concerns. Today, we learned that Solano County Office of Education announced that all public and charter schools will be closed for the next two weeks. North Hills Christian School Board made the determination that we will follow their lead yet implement online learning March 16 – 27. Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students, will continue to receive academic instruction throughout the two week school closure.

- Elementary students: **CAMPUS CLOSED March 16 – 27.**
- 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students **will be in session on March 16<sup>th</sup>** for a minimum day (8:15 – 11:30 AM) to pick up textbooks and materials needed to work at home as well as receive instruction about how to access course work for the coming two weeks. These students **will be home March 17 – 27.** If students are not able to come for the minimum day for this instruction, the school office will be open at 7:00 AM for parents to pick up textbooks.

Elementary students will be assigned daily work on FACTS Family Portal under Homeroom. Each morning you will receive an email with information that teachers may want to provide regarding daily assignments. Teachers will be using Moby Max as one of the primary methods for instruction. These assignments will begin on Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup>. If students are having trouble logging into Moby Max, email your child's teacher and she will confirm the user name and password. Teachers will be calling you on Monday. If you see a North Hills number and are able to pick up the phone, please do so as it will likely be your child's classroom teacher. Further, teachers will be monitoring Moby Max daily and posting grades regularly.

6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will be instructed through Google Classroom. Students currently have access to a Google Classroom for each individual subject. Assignments will be uploaded to each Google Classroom daily. Work will be due by 6:00 PM on the date assigned. Teachers will be available to answer questions throughout the day at normal class times (ie. If class period is 8:15-9:00 AM your teacher will be available through Google Classroom to answer student questions during that time frame.) Students are not required to log in during the class time however teachers will be available should students require assistance. If students are unsure about how to access Google Classroom, teachers will have access codes posted in FACTS Family Portal. In addition, on Monday, every teacher will be verifying that all students are enrolled in the assigned Google Classrooms.

All K-12<sup>th</sup> grade parents/students should send any inquiries regarding class assignments by email to the teacher directly. Teachers will respond during normal school hours (8:15 AM – 3:15 PM).

If you have technical questions we will send an email providing you with a Zoom meeting link for several times throughout the coming week. We will have staff available to answer your questions live. If your child does not have access to a device please email the school office ([school@nhcsvallejo.org](mailto:school@nhcsvallejo.org)).

On a further note:

- All on-campus activities will be canceled including tutoring. However, you should contact the tutor if they are willing to meet off-campus.

- Extended Care will be closed.
- Band will be suspended.
- All Athletic activities are suspended until further notice.
- 4<sup>th</sup> grade Coloma trip will be postponed until a later date.
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade Science camp is still under consideration and families will be advised soon.

Our Fun Run dollars are at work! Because of our fund raising and the added Chromebooks we are pleased to let you know that all of our students have received instruction and are prepared to engage in academic learning through the use of technology. Who knew that the Lord was preparing us for “such a time as this”?
