Throughout the year we have opportunities to be Jesus' hands and feet in the world, helping others in various ways. Sometimes we don't respond to the nudge of the Holy Spirit for some reason, then wish we had—because hands-on-service always tops our lists in church surveys about ministries.

The **Oct 4**th Hands on **Kirkwood** is a one-day mission blitz in our local community; a day when every member of the community is encouraged and empowered to go out and serve. We've all heard the statement, "It is better to give than to receive." Most of us believe this, but few of us find an intentional way to live it. **Hands on Kirkwood** is that intentional way.
