

Renovations to Take Place at South Hamilton

The School Board of Directors approved a revised scope and sequence plan for renovations to South Hamilton Elementary School.

The recommendations are based on extensive discussions that took place at the district's Transportation and Buildings and Grounds Committee meetings that took place earlier this month. At that meeting Dr. Dana Baker, Board president, presented the Transportation Committee's recommendation to perform building improvements during the summer of 2017 and, if necessary, the summer of 2018.

The recommended improvements include: renovate the front entrance, corridor, and reception area to create a security vestibule; replace exterior windows; replace exterior doors/frames; replace metal roof; and upgrade the electrical service and replace the generator. Total estimated costs are \$2,023,616.
