Project Details:

In 2015, Town Council contracted with the aquatic design team of MKSD Architects and Counsilman-Hunsaker pool consultants to determine the best way to preserve and extend the life of the Memorial Park Pool built by the Borough of Chambersburg in 1969. A comprehensive evaluation of the facility, the community, and trends in municipal swimming facilities determined that a complete replacement of the current facility with a new modern family aquatic center designed to today's codes and meeting the demands of today's families was both a prudent economic choice and the best use of the tax resources of the Borough, residents, and businesses. In 2016, a community design effort resulted in the proposal for the enclosed new Memorial Park Family Aquatic Center. While Town Council has already committed to use real estate tax funds to pay for the capital cost of constructing this remarkable regional destination, there remains an opportunity for you, your family, or your business, to make a lasting impact on the community by contributing to the cost of construction of this landmark or by acquiring naming rights.

Construction Schedule:

Construction is set to begin as soon as possible after the end of the 2016 swim season and it will likely extend through 2017. It is possible the new facility will not be fully operational until 2018, but we hope sooner.

Cost of Permits and Admission:

While Town Council has yet to set the seasonal permit rates, the Borough is committed to offering discounts to Borough-residents, discounts for family permits, and scholarships to qualified children and families. Donations to the Recreation Scholarship Fund are always appreciated. It is anticipated that this facility will be a regional destination serving the entire Cumberland Valley.

Name of the Facility:

While the park will remain known as Memorial Park, a unique opportunity exists to add a name to the entire aquatic facility. This opportunity includes: name on the exterior & interior façade of the facility, name on all promotional materials, name on all associated media activity, and recognition at the grand opening of the facility. The facility naming opportunity is a minimum of \$750,000 or 10 years at \$75,000 per year.

Patrons:

Serving a regional community of over 250,000 residents, the facility is anticipated to serve up to 1,100 patrons per day and over 50,000 visitors per year. The surrounding park hosts 20,000 visitors alone for the annual Independence Day event as well as a Latino Heritage event, free concert series, and a huge number of park patrons and day camp visitors. Finally, the facility is clearly visible from I-81 and the main water dump bucket can be used to advertise the facility 28 feet in the air.
