Koenig and Schur named PacWest Players of the Week

IRVINE, Calif. – Hawai'i Pacific University forward [Sven Koenig](#) and goalkeeper [Chandler Schur](#) have been named Pacific West Conference Men's Soccer Players of the Week for their outstanding performances last week.

Koenig, a 6-0 sophomore from Schuete, Germany/Friedrich Bahrens Gymnasium, was honored as the PacWest Co-Player of the Week. Koenig registered nine points on four goals and an assist, as HPU opened the PacWest season with two wins in the Bay Area. In just 22 minutes against Holy Names, he scored three goals and had an assist in a 6-0 win over the Hawks. He had six shots, putting five on goal, and his three scores came within a 16-minute span. He then scored the game-winning goal in a 1-0 overtime win at Dominican. Koenig leads the PacWest in points (17), goals (8) and shots (30).

Schur, a 6-2 freshman from Fayetteville, Pa./Chambersburg Career Magnet, was selected as the PacWest Defender of the Week. Schur anchored the Shark defense that held its first two conference opponents scoreless. He played just the first half against Holy Names, facing four shots. He then recorded his first-career solo shutout in the overtime win at Dominican, making two saves on eight shots.

Joining Koenig as the men's co-player of the week is freshman midfielder Braden Bailey of BYU-Hawaii.

The Sharks will be in action again on Saturday when they visit the Big Island to take on Hawai'i-Hilo in a PacWest game at 12:30 p.m.
