Please remember to bring the following:

- Photo ID or other forms of identification.
- CDC issued vaccination card for 2nd, 3rd or booster vaccines
- Persons under the age of 18 will need to have a parent or guardian present

Examples of proof of age for ages 12 - 17:

- Driver's license or permit (foreign country or expired ID accepted)
- California ID card or REAL ID card (from the DMV)
- Consular ID (Matricula Consular)
- Medicare card
- Membership card (foreign country okay if is written in English)
- Passport (foreign country or expired accepted)
- Birth certificate
- Medical document/records (including immunization records) from medical provider, clinic or doctor
- Any official document that includes name and date of birth (for example school record)

3rd Doses for Immunocompromised Patients

- Can receive the 3rd dose 28 days from 2nd vaccination date.
- Must be receiving active cancer/high-dose corticosteroids treatment, taking medicine to suppress the immune system, or have moderate/severe primary immunodeficiency, advanced/untreated HIV infection.

Boosters for Eligible Patients

- Can receive the booster after 6 months from 2nd vaccination date.
