

Stanley M. Diamond, the executive director and founder of Jewish Records Indexing – Poland Inc. and his wife Ruth celebrated their 175th birthday recently. This was Stan's 90th, with Ruth turning 85. "My wife and I were born five years and five days apart," he explained. Diamond is considered a groundbreaking researcher in genealogy and an author. JRI-Poland is a searchable online database. His commitment to uncovering family histories obscured by war and upheaval has paved the way for countless people of European Jewish ancestry to trace their roots and track down surviving relatives. His personal journey to trace his family lineage not only unveiled surprising connections but also ignited a vision: making genealogical research more accessible for all. JRI-Poland, since its inception in 1995, has become a cornerstone for those tracing their Polish Jewish roots. With collaboration from the Polish State Archives, the organization has built a database of over seven million records. In honor of Diamond's birthday, JRI-Poland kicked off its 2024 NextGen Fundraising Campaign which they usually start in November or December by adding \$90,000 to their goal in recognition of his contribution to this organization. Funds raised will go towards website development project.
