The 100 Black Men of Greater Huntsville, Inc. (100 BMOGH) is pleased to announce its 2021 Scholarship Program. Education is the key to opportunity and is embedded in the mission of our organization. Complete scholarship application must be postmarked or received in the 100 BMOGH business office no later than midnight on **March 1, 2023**. Notification of awards will be sent by **April 1, 2023**. Award letters will be sent to selected applicants only. 100 BMOGH scholarship winners may request presentation of their scholarship award at their annual high school awards program by a member of the 100 BMOGH. Scholarship winners, their family and friends will be honored at a 100 BMOGH Scholarship Awards Ceremony on **April 22, 2023**.

## **Scholarship Criteria**

## Applicants:

The criteria for selecting recipients for 100 BMOGH scholarship awarded to freshmen entering an accredited two or four-year College or university or technical school as a full-time student.

- 1) The applicant must be a US citizen residing in the Greater Huntsville area, consisting of Huntsville, Madison and Madison County; Athens and Limestone County; Decatur and Morgan County.
- 2) The applicant must complete all parts of the application and ensure that all materials supporting his/her application are included (recommendation letters and transcripts must be enclosed in separate, sealed envelopes) and mailed to the 100 BMOGH, at the address below by midnight March 1, 2023.
- 3) Applicants must have no less than a **2.5 cumulative** Grade Point Average upon graduation in order to qualify for a scholarship award (official copy of high school transcript is required).
- 4) In order to be complete, the application package must include:
  - Scholarship application (filled out)
  - Essay (300-word minimum) which will include the following
    - A brief biography
    - Why you wish to attend college
    - How this scholarship will assist in your future goals and career objectives
  - Official copy of student's transcript reflecting quarterly or semester grade point averages
  - Copy of SAT or ACT scores.
  - Counselor's Report
  - Three letters of recommendation; (1) letter from Guidance Counselor (in addition to the counselor's report), and two others
- 5) Immediate family members of the 100 Black Men of Greater Huntsville Inc are not eligible to participate.
- 6) All of the items outlined above must be mailed together (in one package) to the Scholarship Committee. The package must be mailed or postmarked so that it is received in our business office, at the address below by midnight **March 1, 2023**.
