



Welcome to the SJA Reading Olympics

Hello and welcome to the Kickoff of the 2016-17 Saint Joan of Arc Battle of the Books!

Battle of the Books (BOB) is a PSO/Parent run reading competition for Grades 3-8 that begins with a “Kick-off” on Friday November 4th, and ends with a jeopardy-style battle between the finalists from each grade on March 31st. Our goal is to get kids interested in reading.

Each grade will be assigned ten age-appropriate books to read, which were previously voted on by the students or have been chosen by their teachers as required reading in class. As students read, they qualify for various rewards along the way. Students must read (or listen to) at least six of the books to participate in the class battles. See below for more incentives.

What can parents do to help?

- Encourage your child to read and make sure they turn in their review forms (available in classrooms.) You can also print the review form at home (last page of this document.)
- Remind your child of the timeline and prizes they will receive.
- Volunteer as a reader who helps write questions for the battle and read WITH your child!
- Support the **SJA Scholastic Book Fair** which Starts **Nov. 8th** and has many of the BOB books available to purchase for your child or to donate to their classroom.

How does my child get these books?

- There will be at least two copies of each book in each classroom that can be borrowed.
- There will be copies on reserve on the Bookmobile.
- Visit your local libraries.
- Purchase through Scholastic or our SJA Amazon Smile account (link is on the SJA website & in the PSO eblast.) Books marked with an “(S)” may be at the scholastic book fair.

What are the incentives?

Bronze Medal Readers: Read two books & turn in review forms to teacher by **Dec 16th**

Prize - Out of uniform day on **Dec 21st**

Silver Medal Readers: Read four books and turn in review forms to teacher by **Feb 13th**

Prize - Hot chocolate party on **Feb 17th**

Gold Medal Readers: Read at least six books and turn in review forms to teacher by **March 20th** to qualify for the Preliminary Olympic Battles. Reading Olympians will compete against their classmates **March 23 - 28th** for a spot in the Olympic Finals, which will occur on **Friday March 31st!**
