



Crestone Information

Crestone is a very small community with limited shopping and dining options. If you are coming in from Alamosa, there are large markets there (City Market [Kroger], Walmart, Safeway, etc.) that will be cheaper than fare in Crestone, but you can find everything that you need in Crestone. There are also similar markets in Salida, which you will pass by if you are coming from Denver. There is a Dollar General in Moffat, which is about 15 minutes from Crestone. Sometimes (particularly Thursdays) there are foodstuffs for sale by vendors at the Crestone Kiosk, which is the information booth on the main road as you are heading into town.

There are no pharmacies in Crestone, so if you need a prescription filled you can do so in Alamosa or Salida. There is a <u>health clinic</u> in Moffat (15-minute drive) that is open two days per week. Full doctor/hospital services require a drive to Salida or Alamosa.

Elephant Cloud Market is a local organic market. 714.496.0966 Open daily 8-7

*There is a gas station at this market, but there is no other gas near Crestone. We recommend filling up elsewhere on your way, as the gas here is expensive.

Travel to Crestone:

Crestone can be reached via the Denver, CO and Albuquerque or Santa Fe, NM Airports.

From Denver, you can either drive to Crestone (about 3 1/2 hours) or fly to Alamosa, San Luis Valley Regional Airport and then organize transportation to Crestone. Key Lime Air has regular flights from Denver to Alamosa.

From Albuquerque you can drive to Crestone (a little over four hours) or drive from Santa Fe (about 3 1/2 hours).
