

RED RIBBON THEME DAY	WHAT TO WEAR
<b>Thursday, 23 October:</b> "Shade Out Drugs" Day!	Students can wear sunglasses and a baseball cap or visor. Regular uniform is worn. Students going on the field trip will leave these items in school and can wear them in the afternoon. Pumpkin Walk pumpkins are also due today!
Friday, October 24: " Wear Red Day!"	Students may wear a red shirt with uniform or P.E. bottoms this day.
Monday, October 27: "Get in the SPIRIT of Red Ribbon Week!"	Each student may wear SES spirit wear. If they don't have it, the P.E. uniform may be worn.
