



IEPA Stack Testing MOU

- IEPA entered into MOU with UIC (Attachment #6)
- Analyze emission impacts of certain hazardous air pollutants (HAPS) and SO₂ of asphalt plants in a certain geographic area
- IEPA required asphalt plants to perform additional stack testing at the plant's expense (completed late last year)
- IAPA has hired environmental lawyer to represent the industry
