Bethlehem's Citizen of the Year Award recognizes individuals who have made extraordinary contributions to the quality of life in our community. The nominee may be any individual, couple, a community group, a retired person, etc. The nominee should serve as a role model for others, consistently donating time or money to benefit Bethlehem's citizens & organizations. Nominees must reside in Bethlehem for at least one year and may not be a past recipient of a Chamber Award. They may not currently sit on the Chamber Board or be related to a Board Member or Chamber employee. Self nominations and previous nominees are welcome.
