It is time to submit your church's information to the [UCC Yearbook](#). The UCC Data Base and Directories site is now open for you to begin entering your church's information here: <https://engage.suran.com/ucc/s/login>.

Church offices will be emailed the Conference access code needed to enter information this week.

In case you were unaware:

- 1. Your church's 501(c)3 status is dependent on a current updated listing in the UCC Yearbook.**
2. When your church is **searching for a Pastor** you will need current and updated data which comes from the UCC Yearbook. If no reports have been submitted for your church for five (5) years, all data reverts to zeros.
