



Sunday School Coordinator (Part-Time)

Christ Congregational Church (UCC) is looking for a caring, creative, and reliable individual to help lead and grow our Sunday School ministry.

Right now, our program is small, but we are excited about building something meaningful and engaging as our community grows. We are looking for someone who can both care for our kids during Sunday service and who can grow with us as we expand youth programming.

What You'll Do

- Lead Sunday School during worship (currently a small group setting) in a "one room school house" style. (Various ages in one space.)
- Create a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment for children
- Prepare simple, age-appropriate activities or lessons based on United Church of Christ theology.
- Work with church leadership as we gradually build and shape the program
- Help lead occasional special activities (game nights, movie nights, seasonal events, etc.) as the ministry grows

What We're Looking for in You:

- Experience working with children in a church, Sunday School, or similar setting
- Warm, dependable, and engaging with kids
- Comfortable in a progressive, inclusive church environment
- Creative and open to building something new over time
- Organized and able to plan lessons or activities for children of various ages, in collaboration with the Pastor and Church Manager to ensure alignment with the church's values and theology.

Requirements

- High School Diploma with at least 4 years of experience working with children OR Associates Degree with at least 2 years of experience working with children.
- Must speak fluent English
- Must pass a Level 2 background check (required for working with children)
- Reliable transportation and consistent Sunday availability
- Be able to safely supervise and actively engage with children, including leading activities, moving within classroom spaces, and responding appropriately to children's needs.
- CPR Training, or be able to take CPR Training immediately upon accepting the position.
- Sunday School Coordinator **must** also already have their 40 hour child care trainings completed, **or** agree to complete them within the first year of accepting the job, **or** be a certified teacher for the Miami Dade County Public School System.
