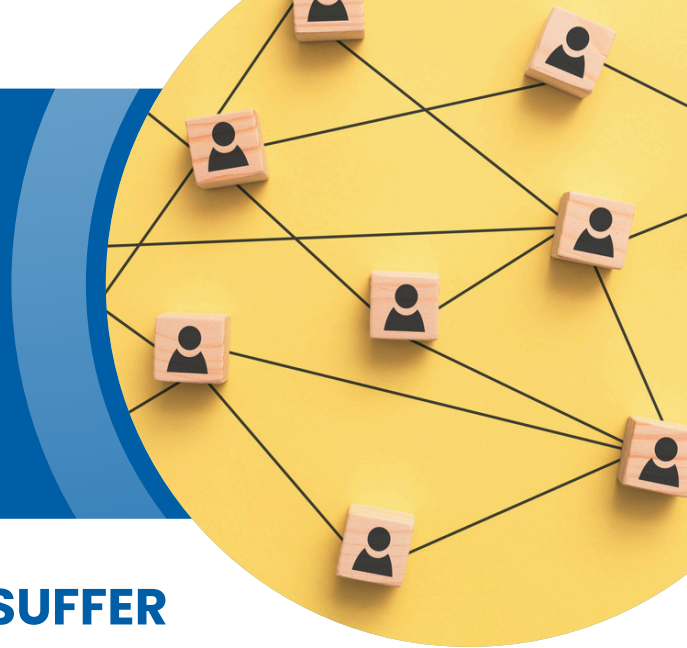


TRAUMA-INFORMED COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE (TI-CoP)

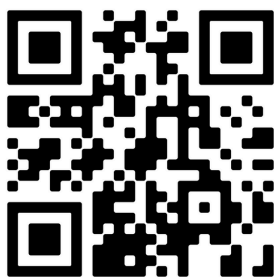


WHEN FAMILIES OR COMMUNITIES SUFFER TRAUMA, EVERYONE IS AFFECTED.
