### **Principal's Report: Mrs. Caywood**

There will be more teacher help this year for our Fun Run. The help will include marketing and class rewards. PO's are ready and have been given to teachers for the amount of \$100 to use toward classrooms.

The water foundation bottle refill was installed before school started this year. Two bottle refill stations were installed on the west hall of the building. Dismissal is getting better by the day. ### **General Business:**

Ginger stated we have over 50 members so far sign up for PTO membership. Tiffany Linley is putting all homeroom mom information in mailboxes of teachers. These moms weren't able to attend the homeroom mom meeting. Teachers are to send the folder home with student. Coach Mitchell went over some estimates she received from Noah's Park to improve the playgrounds. It is estimated to cost \$3,974 for a 2-set swing set with a total of 4 swings. Also, an estimate for a 1 set swing set with a total of 4 swings was \$1,900. To turf just the soccer field part of the playground would cost \$400,000 or \$100,000 for the whole dirt area of the playground. Discussion of a possible merry go round to be added. Coach Mitchell reviewed the equipment purchased

for the playgrounds. Items purchased are attached on the Gopher Order Confirmation form and the remaining money will go toward paint. The paint will be used to paint games on the black top. Coach Mitchell uses the company Gopher because this company will replace any over used or broken equipment. A shade cover for the playground did come up for discussion. The old is being removed because it is unsafe.

### **New Business:**

Erica Bohle brought up the copy machine that is broken. A motion was made for a PO of \$500.00 to fix the machine. Abby Moeller approved the motion and Shelly Nutter 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Santa photos were discussed for our toy drive in December. Elise Breeding said she knew a few people she would ask about being Santa since last years Santa has retired. Abby Moeller had questions on how PO's were approved. There were questions concerning a business fronting the school a purchase then being paid back. Abby asked about sending out a survey for Teacher Appreciation Week. Things teachers liked and disliked in the past. There was a motion for some of our Fun Run fundraiser earnings to go toward a second stage to improve our playgrounds. The motion was approved by Elise Breeding and LaDawna Herriman 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. A playground committee was formed to help with the improvement of the playground. The committee includes Angie Tucker, Sandy Mitchell, Erica Bohle, Julie Ely Stacy Zeama, Abby Moeller and Mr. Roberts. A motion for a PO of \$1,000.00 for Grandparent's Day donuts and drinks was approved by Cole Dewey and 2<sup>nd</sup> by ?.
