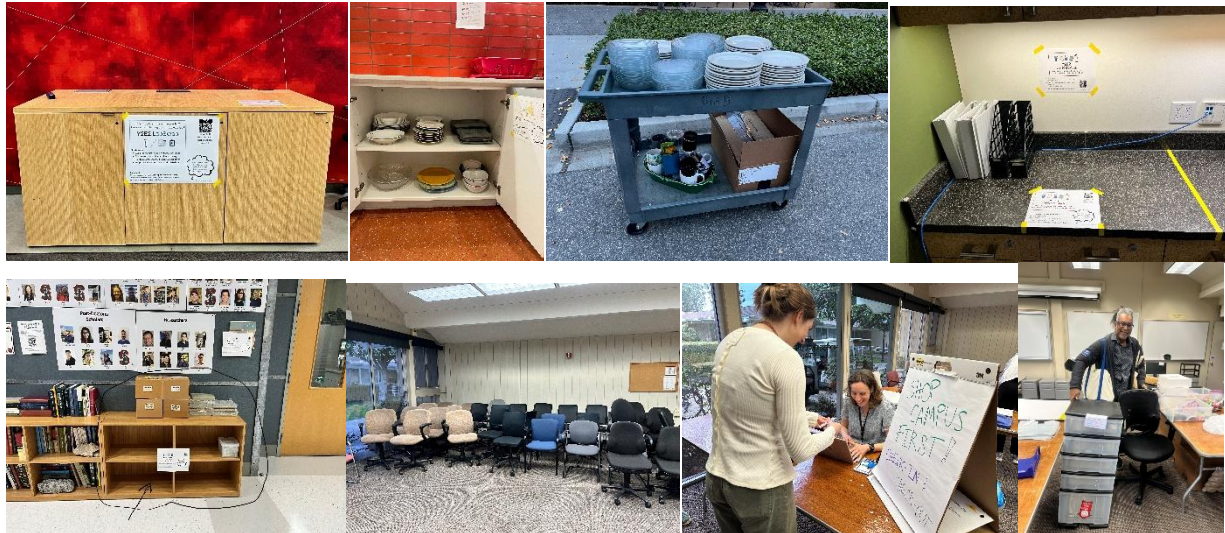




Reuse Pilots Are Live Across Campus!

Stanford's **reuse pilots** are **officially up and running**—and they're already giving office supplies, kitchen dishes, lab materials, tech, and campus merch a second life.



Over the past months, we have set up, and launched **reuse shelves**, a **TechSwap initiative**, and **Shop-the-Building events** in academic buildings, research hubs, student spaces, and administrative offices. These pilots make it easy to **shop campus first** before buying new—saving money, reducing waste, and keeping high-quality items in circulation.

What's live now:

Office supplies swaps in multiple departments and buildings
