The family searched everywhere, put up flyers all over the neighborhood, scoured missing pets' pages on Facebook and called local shelters to no avail. At this point, Felix had been gone 13 days. The family lost hope and started to mourn the loss of Felix forever...

Enter CCR and savior neighbor. Hearing cries up in their cedar tree, a neighbor had been trying for over a week to get someone to come and rescue the cat. Finally they found CCR and Tom was able to come out for the rescue. Climbing the tree, he found the kitty in a cozy nest waiting patiently to be rescued. He was so sweet, and excited for his lift down in the net!

Once Tom had the kitty down, he scanned him for a microchip. But there was no chip (make sure to microchip your pets!). After the neighbor searched the neighborhood pages, they found a missing kitty who looked just like the one Tom rescued. With some sleuthing, they found the house from the photos and tried to return him, but the family wasn't home. The neighbor kept him until they were able to reunite him later that day with his family. This reunion was epic... you can watch the video above! We suggest having tissues ready.

After fearing they lost Felix forever, the family is so grateful for CCR and their neighbor... and had no idea they should look up in the trees for Felix as many people don't! Felix and his family have survived two deep losses and now they are all looking forward to the holidays and some peace. Felix hasn't had the desire to try to escape outside again and his family is making sure he can't find a way to go rogue again!
