

Covenant's Wish List

Updated March 2023

In support of the mission and ministry of Covenant Presbyterian Church, donors may make gifts of any size toward the following:

1. Good Samaritan Fund – formerly “Deacon’s Fund” – funds accessed by staff quietly and confidentially to help Covenant members and other individuals in need. These funds are used for basic human needs such as rent, medical bills, utilities, etc.
2. Medical Mission Endowment Fund – Permanent endowment fund created through irrevocable gifts to the Presbyterian Foundation. Covenant is the recipient of annual distributions which are then used to fund PCUSA and other approved overseas medical missions. Recent donations have funded Medical Benevolence Foundation projects and Village Partners Inc (Haiti).
3. Music Ministry
 - * Organ Maintenance Fund (for major, non-routine maintenance)
 - * Handbell Maintenance Fund (refurbishment)
4. Need-based scholarships for Covenant youth of high school or college age to participate in international mission teams, accompanied by Covenant adults.
5. Transportation Fund – to provide for miscellaneous transportation needs, including the funding of taxi rides to and from church for Covenant members who need rides.
6. Sanctuary Adornment Fund
7. Guatemala - Jorge Ascension, Kidney Anti-Rejection Drug Fund (anticipated need is about \$2,000 per year).
8. Technology updates and improvements

10. Sanctuary Technology Fund
11. Contemporary Worship Fund
12. Covenant Endowment Fund – Permanent endowment fund that provides an annual distribution to Covenant to be used for any of these categories: Mission, theological education, lay leadership training, capital and equipment expenditures, and seed money for new programs.
