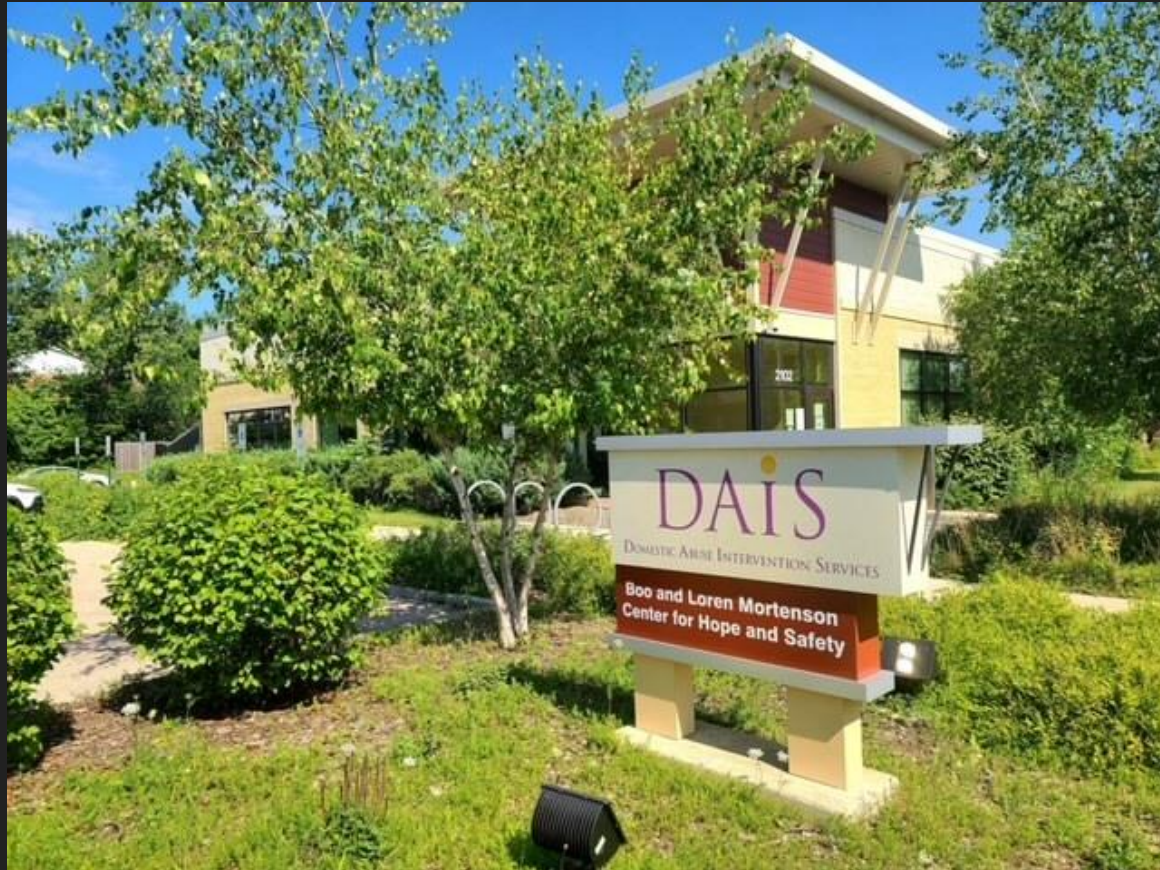

Working Definition of IPV:

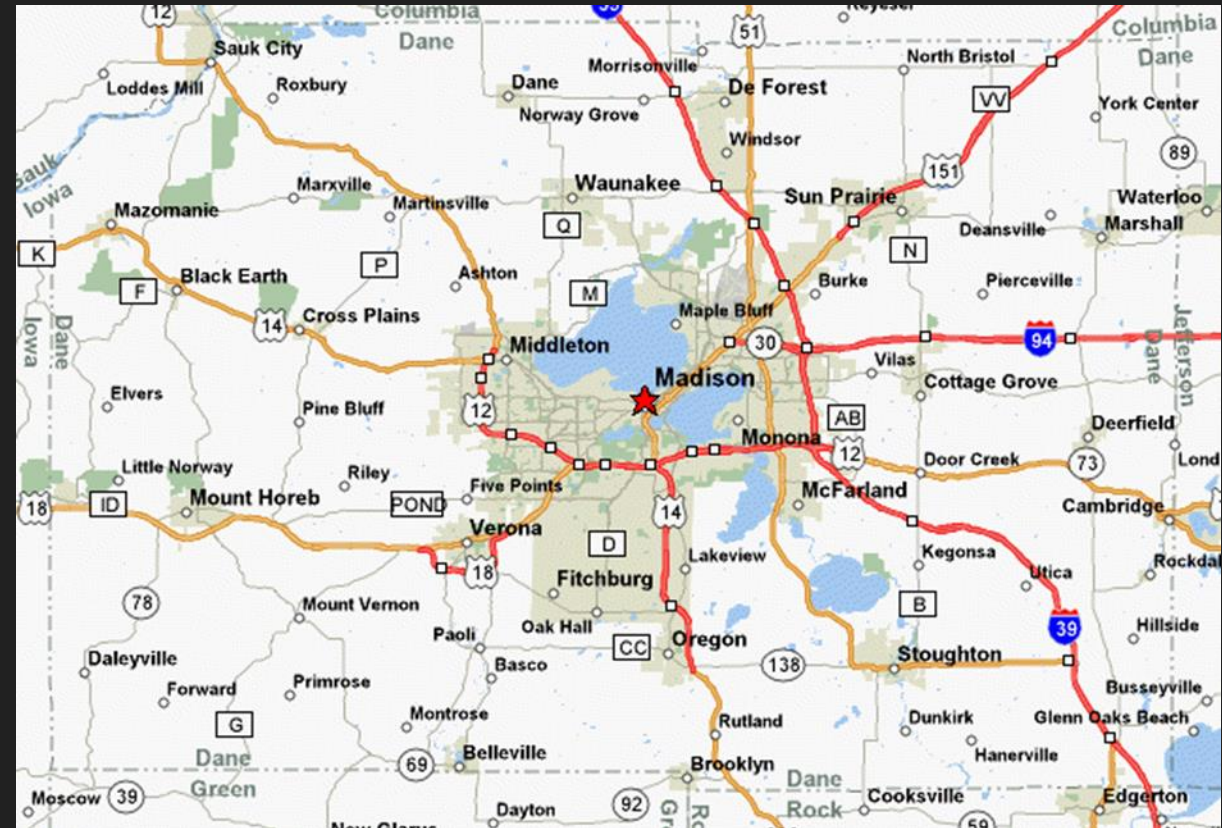
- The intentional use of power and control of one intimate partner over another in order to create and sustain an environment of fear and intimidation.



Who We Serve – Dane County, Wisconsin

Population: 546,695

- Approximately half the population is in the City of Madison
- Poverty Rate: 10.9%
- 5 largest ethnic groups are: White/Non-Hispanic (79.1%), Asian (6.03%), White/Hispanic (5.09%), Black or African American (4.96%), and Two+ (2.79%) and 94.7% of the residents in Dane County, WI are U.S. citizens.
