Health centers tested over **9,400** Tennesseans in the first week of November.

1,493 patients tested positive.

Since April 3, health centers have provided more than **131,000** tests.¹

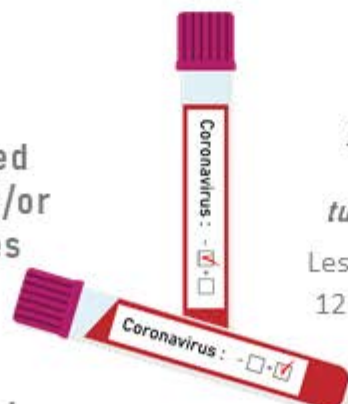
