Qualifications

Nominees must:

- Be under the age of 40 on December 31, 2020
- Possess a valid, unencumbered Tennessee nursing license
- Practice or reside in the state of Tennessee for at least one year

Criteria

Individuals should demonstrate both a commitment to excellence and positive role modeling in the following areas:

- Leadership
- Professional development and growth
- Personal health and wellness
- Promotion of a culture of health

Selection

Program participants will be selected based on the above qualifications and criteria. The selection committee also aims to include diverse individuals representing a variety of Tennessee regions, practice settings, roles, racial/ethnic backgrounds, sexual orientations, and gender identities. While we do not expect personal information to be included in the nomination, please consider diversity so that our 40-Under-40 cohort represents all of Tennessee and the people we serve.
