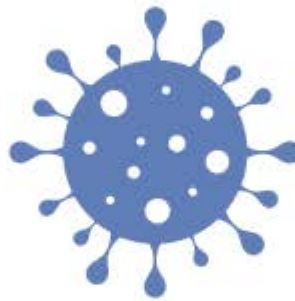

Health Centers are Meeting Testing Needs in Their Communities

Week of March 22 COVID-19 Testing:

100%

of health centers have the ability to test for the virus or antibodies



74%

of health centers have walk-up or drive-up testing

Health centers tested over **2,000** Tennesseans in the last full week of March.

205 patients tested positive.

To date, health centers have provided more than **281,000** tests.¹
