of series initiated were racial and/or ethnic minority patients

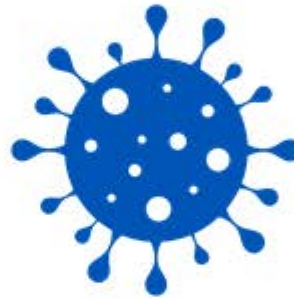

Health Centers are Meeting Testing Needs in Their Communities

300,476 tests administered to date

Health centers tested more than **455** Tennesseans in the fourth week of June.

32 patients tested positive.
