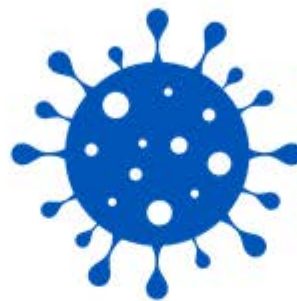

Health Centers are Meeting Testing Needs in Their Communities

96%

of health centers have the ability to test for the virus or antibodies



68%

of health centers have walk-up or drive-up testing

Health centers tested over **6,000** Tennesseans in the second week of September.

847 patients tested positive.

Since April 3, health centers have provided more than **84,000** tests.

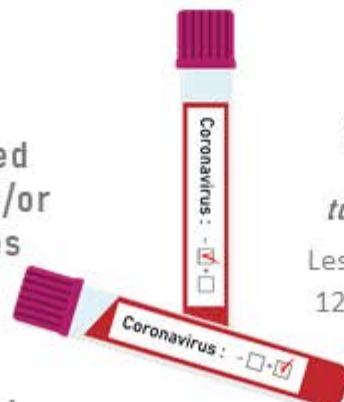
