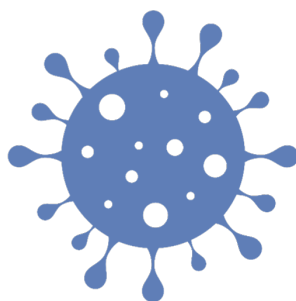

Health centers tested over 1,469 Tennesseans in the third week of May.

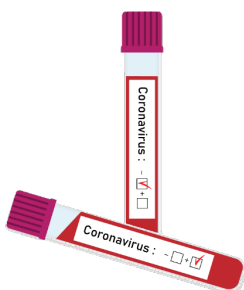
103 patients tested positive.
