What is MCYC? Macomb County 4-H Youth Council was established in 2013. It is a county wide leadership opportunity made up of representatives from each 4-H club within the county. They are the decision making body as to the direction and needs for Macomb County 4-H. In addition the MCYC works together to promote 4-H and plan countywide activities and events.

Michigan 4-H believes that youth should be participants, rather than recipients in the learning process. Extension staff and Adult Advisors work together to teach youth about strengthening youth voice and youth-adult partnerships at the club and county level. The Council provides an outlet for youth voice at the County level.

DUTIES

- Arrive at least 30 minutes early to help set up for each meeting.

- Attend all county 4-H Council meetings.
- Report your club activities and recommendations at each County Council meeting.
- Report on County Council activities, recommendations, committee reports and activities of other clubs at your local club meeting.
- Serve on countywide committees when appointed by the County Council chairman/president.
- Recruit older members of the club to serve on countywide committees.
- Participate in training opportunities at county, district and state levels.
