The Scottish American Society of the Southern Tier to hold Tartan Day Celebration, Tuesday, April 6, 2021, Centennial Park, Corning, N.Y., 6 p.m. - 7 p.m.

Corning, New York, March 31, 2021 — In celebration of the 801<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Arbroath, <u>The Scottish</u> American Society of the Southern Tier is holding a Tartan Day Celebration on Tuesday, April 6, 2021 from 6 p.m. - 7 p.m. in Centennial Park, Corning, N.Y. The Declaration of Arbroath was a call for the right of Scots to rule themselves and helped shape the American Declaration of Independence.

The Celebration will commence with an Invocation by the Reverend Joshua Barrett and a Proclamation from the Mayor of Corning followed by a short Kirkin' O' the Tartans ceremony. Capping off the Celebration, will be a Tattoo by the award winning <u>Caledonian Highlanders Pipe & Drum Band</u>.

Steuben County Department of Health contact-tracing requirements require that SASST only allow 25 groups of no more than (6) people in the Quarantined Area (see below) of Centennial Park. Once the twenty-five (25) reserved spots are claimed, the public is nonetheless invited to attend keeping socially-distanced along the pedestrian bridge, sidewalks or otherwise outside the Quarantined Area of Centennial Park.
