- Sign-up as a speaker about career related topics and experiences
- Help students on special projects
- Help students with resource materials in the library
- Assist students with various special needs
- Assist in science labs
- Assist in vocational classes
- Accompany students on choral, band, club or athletic trips

- Assist students in art, music, acting, etc.
- Help arrange field trips
- Sponsor school clubs
- Assist in developing school publications
- Assist in putting on student performances
- Help students with homework and make-up assignments
- Help non-English speaking students with vocabulary and conversational skills

- Assist athletic coaches
- Serve as Mentors/Tutors
- Assist in arranging and supervising special school event
