

## Joseph A. Melbourne, Jr. Scholarship Program

*January 1 – March 1, 2020*

<b>Details:</b>	<p>The Joseph A. Melbourne Jr. Annual Scholarship Program, named after Addition Financial's former President and CEO, will award the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Six (6) undergraduate scholarships in the amount of \$10,000 to be distributed over four years (\$2,500 per year)</li> <li>• Two (2) masters-level scholarships in the amount of \$2,500, distributed in a lump sum to recipients on a one-time basis</li> </ul> <p>Recipients will be selected on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis.</p>

<b>Eligibility Criteria:</b>	<p>To be eligible to apply, each applicant must meet <b>ALL</b> of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All applicants must be a current account holder, joint account holder, or named on a custodial account in good standing with Addition Financial at the time of application submittal and scholarship award payout.</li> <li>• Undergraduate applicants must be accepted into or enrolled in an accredited undergraduate program at a college, trade school, or university that is located in the state of <b>Florida</b>. (minimum 12-credit hour semester or full-time equivalent)</li> <li>• High school applicants must have a current cumulative grade point average (GPA) of a 3.0 or higher.</li> <li>• Master's level applicants must be accepted into or enrolled into a master's level program at the <b>University of Central Florida</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Entry Requirements:</b>	<p>When submitting the online application, all applicants must include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Academic transcript(s): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ High school applicants - must supply transcript copy for all classes taken in grades 9-12. Must show current GPA.</li> <li>➤ Master's applicants - must supply transcript copy of most recent classes taken. Must show current GPA.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Two essay questions – 50 words or less</li> <li>• Letter of recommendation – letter should include applicant's demonstrated community service efforts.</li> </ul>
<b>Timeline and Judging:</b>	<p>The online application must be submitted by <b>Sunday, March 1, 2020</b>. Applications will be reviewed and judged by a scholarship committee within the credit union. Personal information will be redacted prior to review by the scholarship committee. Missing information within application will result in disqualification. The credit union is under no obligation to contact applicants regarding missing information. Winners will be selected and notified by March 31, 2020.</p>
