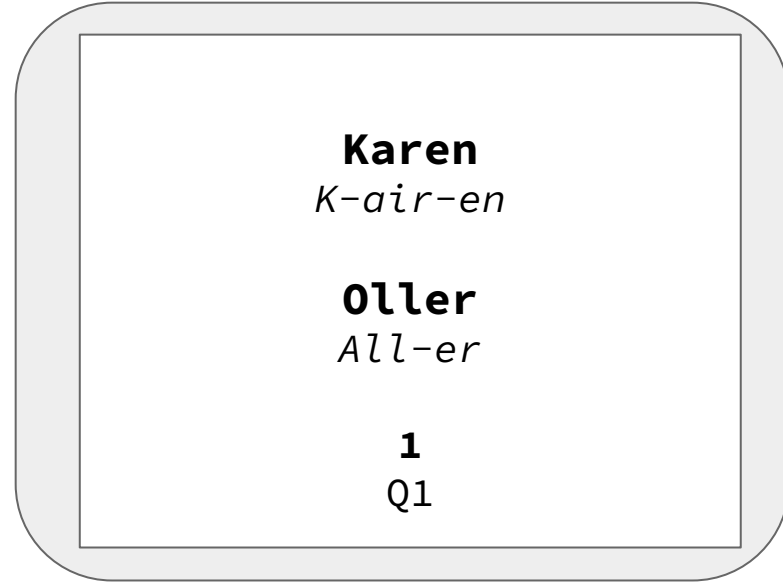
- Leave your phone in the car or give it to a family member

You will survive! :)



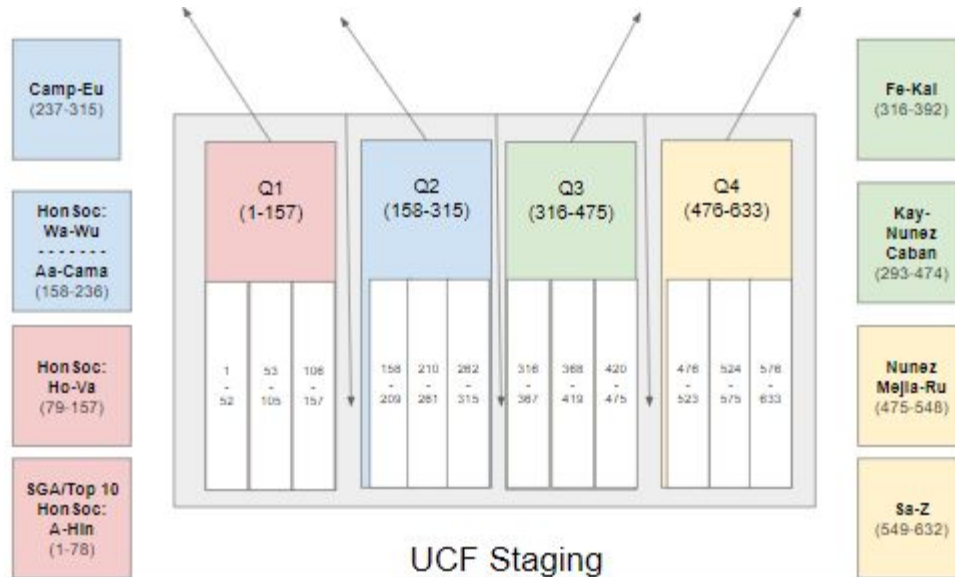
WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN THE STAGING AREA

1. You will receive your color-coded name card
 - ◆ The name card is what you will give to the person reading your name when you cross the stage
 - ◆ DO NOT LOSE YOUR CARD
 - ◆ Your card also has your spot number in line
2. You will get in a designated (color-coded) line to walk out into the arena.

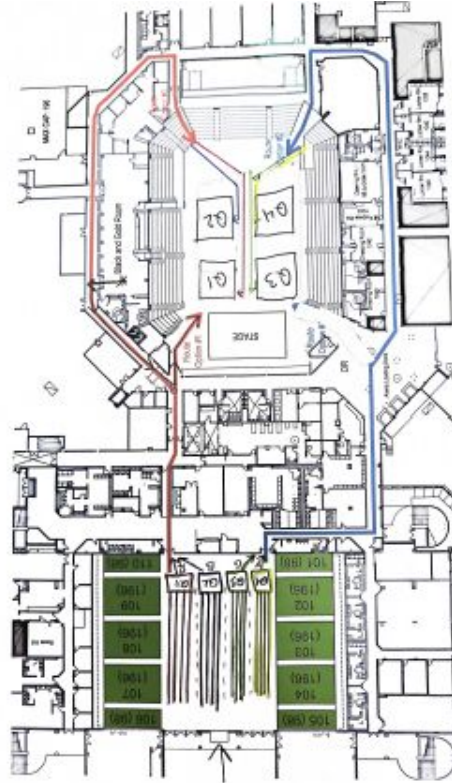


ONCE YOU GET YOUR NAME CARD...

1. Look for your color-coded zone and find your proper line, according to your number.
2. Stand in line, in numerical order until it's time to leave, then follow the person in front of you all the way into the arena

- There will be 4 lines entering the arena - *follow the people in front of you and listen to the people directing you*
- **Stay standing when you arrive at your seat**

Arena Map

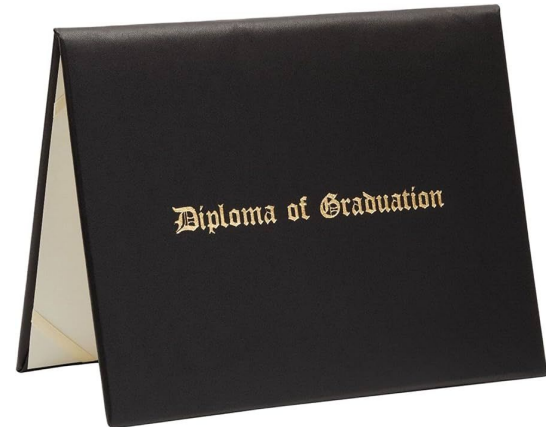

WALKING ACROSS THE STAGE

- Your hands must be empty (with the exception of your name card)
- Hand shakes and questions
- You will be receiving your diploma cover – not your diploma



WARDROBE UNDER YOUR ROBE

- Dress shoes, slacks, collared dress shirt, and tie/bowtie
- Dress, dress pants, blouse, dress sandals/shoes
- Do **not** wear flip flops, jeans, t-shirts, or sneakers



ROBE ITSELF

- You **cannot** decorate the cap or robe
- There are instructions for how to wear the cap inside the cap
- Tassel is on right (*it's right if it's on the right*)
- Only nationally recognized cords will be worn - *only 4 different stoles*
- Make sure you have your tassel and your Boone stole

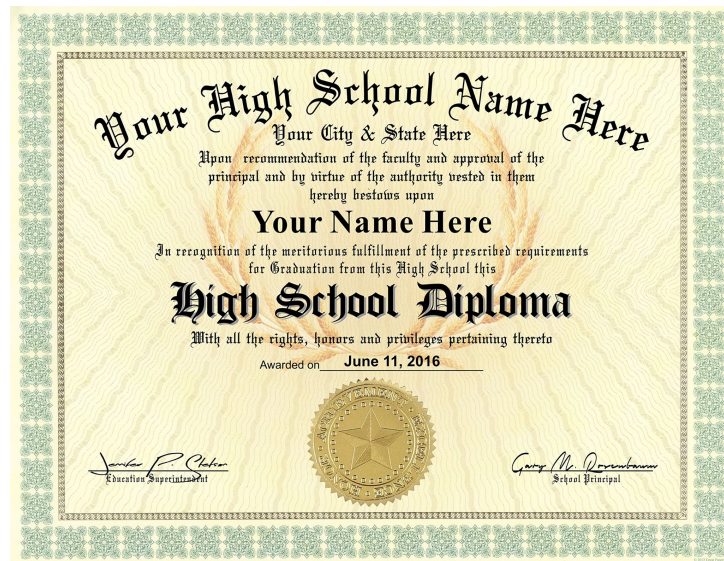
