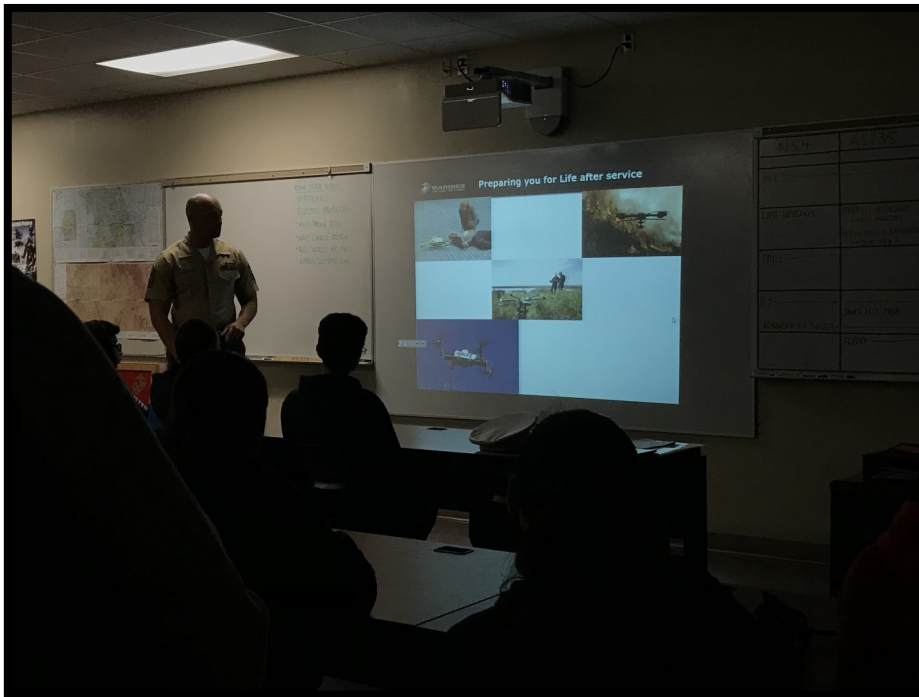




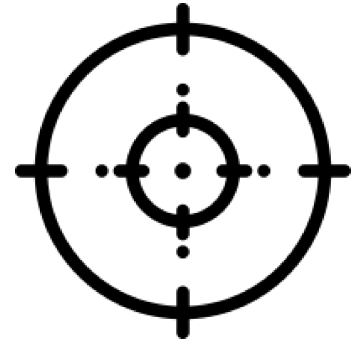
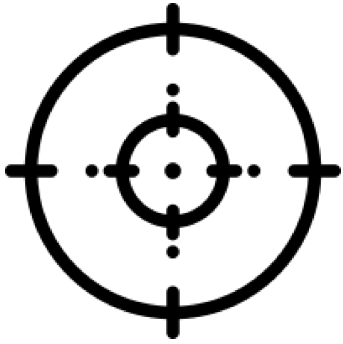
HONOR COURAGE COMMITMENT
