One grade level winner daily. • Students submit a photo(s) to the Student Body CANVAS page reading (i.e. a picture of a book in their hands reading to your pet or a picture of a book in their hands with a beautiful park in the background, etc.); names entered into a drawing to win a prize. • Visit the media center to check out a book. LaunchED@Home students may request a book via the Google Form in the LNMS Student Body Course • Use Beanstack in Launchpad to record the number of minutes you've read this week in the #WinterRead2021 challenge. • Door Decorating Contest: Teachers and students will be encouraged to decorate their classroom door in a manner that best showcases the theme of <i>Humanity Tells a Story</i>. Top 3 teachers win a prize! • Caught You Reading! Leadership team members will be supplied treats and small prizes to pass out as they see kids reading around campus. If possible, capture a snapshot first and send to Powers for the Chronicle. • Bookmark Contest: Interested students can pick up a bookmark template in the media center and design a bookmark around the theme <i>Humanity Tells a Story</i>.
