Topic: Virtual meetings: Results from the National Dental PBRN CORE Registry Study

Description: We invite all National Dental PBRN practitioners to attend one of three virtual meetings to review and discuss important preliminary results from the CORE Study survey that was conducted in Jan 5 – Feb 14, 2021.

Study overview: The purpose of the study was to obtain information from dental practitioners regarding effective approaches to mitigate SARS-CoV-2 transmission risks, their costs, and assess practitioners' comfort levels with these approaches. We recruited 1529 active U.S. dentists, dental hygienists, and dental therapists who were enrolled in the National Dental PBRN as of 01/04/2021.

Topics: Key survey responses are presented by practice setting and practice type. Topics to be discussed:

1. Low levels of confidence about financial sustainability of dental practice
2. Frequency of patient's concerns about safety and skepticism
3. Reported approaches to minimize/manage aerosol generation
4. Dental office policies/practices to reduce risks for staff
