









TRUMP CAMPAIGN AND RNC ANNOUNCE KANSAS TEAMS

Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. and the Republican National Committee (RNC) today announced the members of the Kansas Trump Victory effort, which will win the great state of Kansas once again for President Trump and Republicans up and down the ballot. BACKGROUND

Since President Trump was elected, he has added 32,700 jobs to Kansas' economy, adding 7,100 jobs in the manufacturing sector while President Obama lost 18,800 manufacturing jobs in the state. Trump has lowered the state's unemployment rate from 4% to 3.2% after the state hit an unemployment peak of 7.2% under President Obama. Additionally, President Trump has added money back into the paychecks of Kansas voters, with the average Kansas taxpayer receiving a tax cut of \$1,410. President Trump has lifted the prospect of voters across Kansas, overseeing a decline of 39,423 Kansas residents on food stamps.
