LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

There were no bills relating to fishing introduced this week. The shellfish bill we've been waiting on is still being drafted. A "certain organization" sent a note to legislators saying things are terrible for recreational fishermen in North Carolina and it's all the fault of inshore trawling and gillnets, so that could be a sign something is coming.

Most of the legislative committee meetings have been background information on various state agencies and preliminary discussions on appropriations. The General Assembly will remain in session until a budget is passed by the Senate, House and signed by the Governor.
