Hoop No-Show Stabilizer with 14" x 22" Fusible Fleece with the fusible side facing up.

Cut Out two panels

Mark centers

Center in hoop and fuse

Trim 1 3/4" beyond the bunnies, so your placemat will be approx. 17 1/2"x13".

Cut your 1 yard of yellow fabric into 4 equal pieces.

Oh No! The thread ends show through the wrong side.

Cut a piece of No-Show 17 1/2" x 13" and glue stick it to the back to hold in place. Trim if necessary. This will hide those threads.

Position your backing fabric so there is at least 2" all around.

Trim backing fabric to 2" beyond the front.

Miter the corners by following the direction that come with the Mitered Binding Tool.
