293. Embroidery

Step 1: Hoop No-Show Stabilizer

Lay a 13" x 16" piece of Fusible fleece with the fusible side facing up.

Trim off the excess Fusible Fleece

Step 2: Lay a piece of the fabric you want to use for the center over the egg.

Stitch the inner egg

Trim off the excess leaving a 3/8" seam allowance

Step 3: Thread your machine with bright yellow and sew the first fancy fill.

Step 4: Sew the Inner Fancy Fill with Exquisite 5554 Blue

Step 5: Lay a 15" x 12" Navy blue border fabric over the egg. Stitch the outer egg straight stitch. Trim away the center

Step 6: Stitch the candlewicking

Step 7: Sew the Tassels in Dark Blue

Step 8: Sew the Candlewicking in green

Step 9: Sew the tear drops in green

Step 10: Sew the flower center dots in yellow

Step 11: Sew the inside of the flower in blue #409

Step 12: Sew the feather trim in dark blue

Step 13: Trim the tear drops with bright yellow

Step 14: Trim the flowers with dark blue

Step 15: Sew the satin stitch hearts in dark blue

Step 16: Sew the bean stitch in bright yellow

Step 17: Fold two pieces of 12" x 15" fabric in half lengthwise. Position with the fold at the center overlapping by at least 1/2". Sew the outer egg with a straight stitch.

Trim seam allowance to 3/8"

Turn and press.
