Angel with stippling

Add the lettering "Angels we have heard on hig

6" x 9" Rectangle with straight stitch

6" x 9" Rectangle with Candlewicking

8" x 11" Rectangle with Straight Stitch

8" x 11" Rectangle with zig zag

- 10. Angel Continuous Line
- 11. Click on it
- 12. Set
- 13. Click on the zig zag at the bottom of your screen
- 14. Triple Stitch
- 15. Red

- 20. 90 degrees counterclockwise 23:00
- 21. Lighten the background image so you don't see it

## To quilt the border:

- 1. Embroidery
- 2. Q Menu
- 3. Select the border you like I'm using 007
- 4. Set
- 5. All in one
- 6. 8.5" wide
- 7. 11.4" tall
- 8. 1.2" border width
- 9. I'm using the 9.5" x 14" Magnetic hoop
- 10. Next
- 11. Tell it triple stitch or single stitch
- 12. Memory
- 13. OK
- 14. Select your design
- 15. Set
- 16. Embroidery
- 17. Projector
- 18. Check all four corners
- 19. Move the design until you like what you see.
- 20. OK
- 21. OK
- 22. Matching thread in the bobbin and top.
- 23. Embroider!!
