9. Make it as big as it will go 9.27" x 10.71"

86. Straight Line (next to bucket)
87. Draw a V shaped line using your grid lines
88. Zoom in to 200%
89. Do not let the line touch the triangle. Erase if you need to.
90. And another one about 1 1/4" away
91. Memory
92. Save on the machine

94. No Sew

97. Click on the black line to turn it gray
98. Line Properties
99. Straight Stitch

103. Click on the "V" lines to turn them red

Center of the Table Topper

Hoop your topper with the center in the middle.

We used the 10" x 10" hoop.

We did not use any additional stabilizer.

1. IQ Designer
2. Leaf with arrow
3. Image Scan
4. Scan
5. Darken the screen if you can't see the image
6. Shapes
7. #20
8. OK
9. Size
10. Shrink it down to 5" x 5"
11. Line Properties
12. Straight Stitch
13. Red
14. Ok
15. Line Bucket
16. Click on the line to turn it red
17. Next
18. Memory
19. Save on the machine
20. Set
21. Ok
22. Edit
23. Copy
24. Move
25. Center
26. OK
27. Add
28. IQ Designer
29. Pocket with arrow
30. Select your shape in the upper left
31. Line Properties
32. Candlewicking (Satin stitch might have been better.)
33. Blue
34. OK
35. Line Bucket

36. Click on the line to turn it blue
37. Next
38. Size .160" to ???
39. Spacing ???
40. Set
41. Ok
42. Make sure it is one on top of the other.
43. Embroidery
44. Try the projector
45. Take a picture with the camera
46. Scan
47. Ok
48. Ready to sew!!!
