Use your largest hoop

20" x 24" No Show on bottom

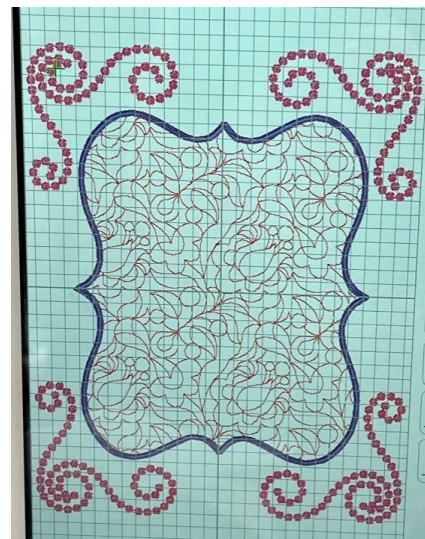
18" x 23" Fusible Fleece (with fusible side facing up) on the top

For each placemat have ready:

1 10" x 12" center fabric Yellow Fairy Frost

1 15" x 20" Fabric for border.

1. IQ Designer
2. Settings
3. Select the 9 1/2" x 14" hoop for reference
4. Shapes
5. Curl
6. Scroll Corners
7. OK
8. Deselect
9. Select Menu at bottom of screen
10. Draw a box around each corner and move them out of the way. Space them evenly. Turn on your grid
11. Memory pocket with an arrow pointing in
12. Save on machine
13. All Clear

15. Shapes
16. Flag
17. Fancy Square Top row Far right

Step 1: Center a 10" x 12" piece of Fairy Frost in the center and fuse
Embroider Fancy Fill with MA10 Kingstar

Step 2: Embroider the outline

Step 3: Center 1 15" x 20" Border fabric and fuse
Embroider the tack down straight stitch. Trim away the center fabric.

Step 4: Stitch the Satin Stitch in White

Step 5: Embroider the Bean Stitch

Step 6: Embroider the candlewicking
