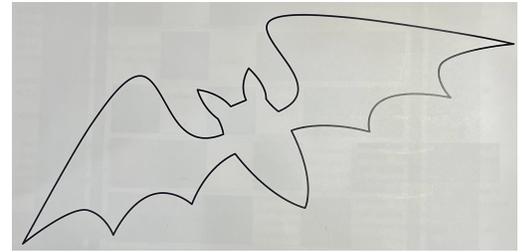

Going A Little Batty Applique

IQ Designer



- Take a picture of the bat from your pattern.
- If you are satin stitching your bat, thread your machine with dark gray in the top and black in the bobbin.
- If you are blanket stitching, thread your machine with black in the top and bobbin.
- Fuse Featherweight Hotfix to the back of your black fabric.

1. Open IQ intuition Positioning App
2. Select image for creating design.
3. Select the picture of the bat.
4. Send to the machine.
5. IQ Designer
6. Leaf
7. Line Design
8. Wifi
9. Top Image
10. Set
11. Crop
12. Line Properties
13. Running Stitch
14. Red
15. OK
16. OK
17. Set
18. Zoom in to 200%
19. Pan so you can see the words.
20. Click outside the red box so the bat is no longer selected.
21. Erase or Select the words by clicking and dragging a box around the words, and cut.
22. Go back down to 100%



23. Select the bat.
24. Size
25. Measure the bat on your paper pattern and make sure it is the same size. Adjust size if necessary. 4" x 8"
26. Memory
27. Save on the machine.

- Step 1: Using your projector, position the bat. Page 4 of 12 Turn off the light.
Stitch the placement line
- Step 2: Position an 8"x5" piece of Black fabric (fused with Featherweight Hotfix) over the placement line, stitch, trim and press.
- Step 3: Satin stitch the bat.

To quilt with your bat design, just stitch step 1.
