June 12, 2022
Elegant Trapunto Hearts and
Butterflies with Micro-Stippling

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You will need:

- One 20" x 18" Ivory Solid (In Kit)
- One 20" x 18" Cotton Batting (In Kit)
- One (or two) 11"x 11" High Loft Batting (In Kit)
- One 20" x 20" No Show Stabilizer
- Exquisite Thread one shade darker or matching your fabric.

Hooing order:

- No Show Stabilizer on Botton
- Cotton Batting
- High Loft Batting centered in hoop floating
- Ivory solid Fabric on Top

Raise your embroidery foot height one number.

1. IQ designer
2. Shapes
3. Hoops
4. 9 ½" x 9 ½"
5. OK
6. Shapes
7. Curly Cue
8. Third row down, second from left Heart in each corner
9. OK
10. Line Properties To draw a line to close up the butterfly so it will be puffy.
11. Straight Line
12. Black
13. OK
14. Zoom in to 400%
15. Move the red box so you can see a butterfly.
16. Draw two lines on each butterfly to close it up.

17. Move the red box to the next butterfly. Close up all four butterflies.
18. Memory pocket with the arrow pointing in.
19. Save on the Machine
20. Shapes We're going to add the heart in the middle
21. Heart
22. Ok
23. Size 4.89" x 5.27"
24. OK
25. Copy
26. Size to 3.80" x 3.97"
27. Center
28. OK
29. Line Properties Now to add stitches!!
30. Bean Stitch (Triple Stitch)
31. Deep Pink
32. OK
33. Line Bucket
34. Touch the smallest Heart
35. Line Properties
36. Candlewicking
37. Red
38. OK
39. Line Bucket
40. Click on the larger heart
41. Line Properties
42. Candlewicking
43. Purple
44. OK
45. Line Bucket
46. Click on each one of the four swirls around the butterflies to turn them purple.
47. Line Properties
48. Satin Stitch
49. Blue
50. OK
51. Click on all the butterfly parts to turn them blue
52. Fill Properties
53. Stippling Stitch
54. Orange
55. OK
56. Fill Bucket
57. Touch the background to fill it with stippling
58. Fill Properties

59. Circle Button
60. Select
61. 004 Roses
62. OK
63. Green
64. Ok
65. Touch inside the smaller heart to fill it with roses
66. Memory pocket with the arrow pointing in
67. Save on the machine
68. Next This is where you can make changes
69. The stippling should be in the window.
70. Run Pitch from .080" down to .052" Set
71. Spacing down as small as it will go to 0.080" Set
72. Distance down to 0.000" so there is no gap. Set
73. Select until you see the roses in the window
74. Lower left 100% button, size down to 75% Set
75. Select so you see purple candlewicking in the window.
76. Do Not LINK
77. Size down to 0.132"
78. Spacing keep at 0.040"
- 79.
80. Select until another purple candlewicking is in the window. Make sure the size is 0.132" and the spacing is 0.040"
81. Keep selecting until you are sure all the purple candlewicking is the same.
82. Select so the blue Satin Stitch is in the window
83. Link
84. Stitch width keep at 0.080"
85. Density up to 110%
86. Select until the red candlewicking is in the window
87. Size up to 0.216" Set
88. Spacing down to 0.020" Set
89. Memory pocket with an arrow pointing in.
90. Save on the Machine
91. Preview
92. Set
93. OK
94. Embroidery
