Micro-Stippling on You will need:

One 20" x 18" linen with gold (In kit)

One 20" x 18" cotton batting (In kit)

One 10' x 10' high loft batting (In kit)

one 20" x 20" No Show Stabilizer

Exquisite Thread one shade darker or matching thread



No Show Stabilizer on bottom

Cotton batting

High loft batting centered in hoop floating

Linen fabric on top

Raise your embroidery foot up one number

Pillow Construction

Make the Mini Piping with the 1" x 44" strip, cording and Baby Lock Mini Piping Foot.

Trim piping seam allowance to 1/4" using the Add-A-Quarter ruler.

Cut the 44" piping into 4 equal pieces.

Sew the piping to the right and left side of the embroidery on the pillow front,

using the Mini-Piping foot. Line

up the stitched seam on the piping with the

edge of the embroidery (Joanie peeked underneath as she was sewing to make sure it was lining up.)

Repeat for the top and bottom of the pillow front.

Trim the wool batting and ivory fabric close to the piping seam allowance. Do not trim off the cotton batting. You will still have cotton batting on all four sides. You will want to leave it under the border fabric.

Take one of your 4" \times 44" fabrics and cut two pieces 11 ½" \times 4". Sew with right sides together to the right and left side, using the Mini Piping Foot. Press towards border fabric.

Take your other 4" x 44" fabric cut two pieces 17" x 4". Sew to top and bottom. Press seam allowance towards the border.

Square the pillow front to 16 1/2" x 16 1/2"

Overlapped Pillow Back

Cut your 17" \times 44" backing fabric on the fold so you will end up with two pieces 17" \times 22" (approx.)

Fold both in half to 17" x 11" and press.

Place right sides together matching raw edges on the right and left side.

Your top and bottom will be slightly bigger.

Place folded edges overlapping at the center.

Stitch 1/4" from the pillow front edges.

Trim excess, turn and press.

Stuff with a 16" pillow form and enjoy your handiwork!
