- 1. Embroidery
- 2. #4 Large Letters
- 3. 01 Letters with Flowers
- 4. Scroll down to the smaller size (starts at 027)
- 5. Choose your letter Mine is 034 H
- 6. Set
- 7. Settings Page 8 of 12 Grid: 1" Grid OK
- 8. Settings Page 9 of 12 Change to inches
- 9. Edit
- 10. Size
- 11. Resize
- 12. OK
- 13. From 2.06" x 1.74" to 1.81" x 1.54"
- 14. OK
- 15. Add
- 16. Menu 6
- 17. 02 Fancy Buttonhole
- 18. 001 Leaves with yellow and orange flowers
- 19. Set
- 20. Edit
- 21. Size
- 22. Resize
- 23. OK
- 24. Down to 1.07" x 2.30"
- 25. OK
- 26. Rotate
- 27. 10 degrees Clockwise
- 28. Move to where you like it.
- 29. OK
- 30. Copy
- 31. Mirror
- 32. Move to right side, opposite the first one
- 33. Mine ended up at 1.14" x .91"



- 34. The one on the left is 1.14" x -0.91"
- 35. OK
- 36. Copy
- 37. Rotate
- 38. Center
- 39. Rotate to 180 degrees Clockwise (so it has 40 degrees in the window) and move into place. Watch the numbers on the move screen, mine is -1.06" x -0.91"
- 40. OK
- 41. Copy
- 42. Mirror
- 43. Move into place
- 44. Zoom in and make sure nothing is touching.
- 45. I had to move my H up a little.
- 46. OK
- 47. Memory
- 48. Save on the machine
- 49. Color Change
- 50. Change your letter to Harvest Gold
- 51. 2<sup>nd</sup> Color Cream Brown
- 52. 3<sup>rd</sup> Color Carmine change to Tangerine
- 53. 5<sup>th</sup> Color Mint Green change to Lime Green
- 54. OK
- 55. Memory Save on the machine

## **Tissue Box Front, Top and Back:**

- 1. Home
- 2. OK
- 3. IQ Designer
- 4. Shapes
- 5. Square
- 6. OK
- 7. Size
- 8. Measure your box and make your rectangle ½" bigger.
- 9. I am making mine 5" wide x 15 1/2" long
- 10. Center
- 11. OK
- 12. Shapes
- 13. Circle
- 14. OK
- 15. Measure your tissue box opening and make this circle into an oval

and 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " smaller. My box opening is 4" x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " so I am making my oval 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1".

- 20. Line Properties
- 21. Straight Stitch
- 22. Red
- 23. OK
- 24. Line Bucket
- 25. Click on the rectangle and the oval
- 26. Fill Properties
- 27. Fancy Fills
- 28. Select
- 29. 013 Looks like the embroidery design.
- 30. OK
- 31. Red
- 32. OK
- 33. Fill Bucket
- 34. Click inside to fill it.
- 35. Memory Save on the machine
- 36. Next
- 37. Set
- 38. OK
- 39. Add
- 40. IQ Designer
- 41. Memory Pocket with the arrow pointing out
- 42. Select your outline Should be top row, second from left.
- 43. OK
- 44. Line Properties
- 45. No Sew
- 46. OK
- 47. Line Bucket
- 48. Click on the rectangle to make it not sew.
- 49. Line Properties
- 50. Zig Zag
- 51. Red
- 52. OK
- 53. Line Bucket
- 54. Click on the oval.

- 55. Next
- 56. Density
- 57. 110%
- 58. Zig Zag Width from 0.080" to 0.160"
- 59. Set
- 60. OK
- 61. Make sure everything is in the center: Edit Move Center
- 62. Select Center Select Center
- 63. Select the satin stitched oval
- 64. Edit
- 65. Copy
- 66. Move
- 67. Center
- 68. OK
- 69. Embroidery
- 70. Memory
- 71. Save on the machine
- 72. Sew this out first

### Add your monogram design:

- 2. Embroidery
- 3. Memory Pocket

### **Tissue Box Sides:**

- 1. My tissue box sides measured 5" tall x 4 1/8" wide
- 2. So I am making the sides 5 3/4" tall x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide
- 3. Home
- 4. IQ Designer
- 5. Shapes
- 6. Square

- 7. OK
- 8. Size
- 9. 5.75" tall x 4.5 Wide
- 10. Move it one inch up from center
- 11. OK
- 12. Copy
- 13. Size
- 14. Center
- 15. Move 1" down from center
- 16. OK
- 17. Line Properties
- 18. Straight stitch
- 19. Red
- 20. OK
- 21. Line bucket
- 22. Click on the lines to turn them red
- 23. Fill Properties
- 24. Fancy Fills
- 25. Select
- 26. 013
- 27. OK
- 28. Red
- 29. OK
- 30. Fill Bucket
- 31. Click inside each rectangle to fill
- 32. Next
- 33. Preview
- 34. Memory
- 35. Save on the machine
- 36. Set
- 37. OK
- 38. Embroider
